FROM THE PASTOR
AUGUST, 2019

Greetings in the name of Christ!

We have had lots of good things happening in the life of the church in July. **We had a tremendous VBS! We had 58 children attending and over 40 adults helping out.** Each night was filled with fun activities in recreation, storytelling, crafts, science and music. Each theme of the night shared the good news of God's love for all of us.

We are making plans for all kinds of **fall activities including square dancing, Wednesday youth, bike riding, game nights and more.** Also, on September 8th at 5:00 p.m. we will have a **high school confirmation class.** I am looking forward to this time with our youth. September 14th we will have a **bike ride** in the morning and a **game night** that evening. Check the website and emails for updates during the month.

We are also asking for people to join in a **ministry of prayer for our school teachers, administrators, and support staff during this school year.** If you are interested in this **ministry** let the church office know. We hope to distribute the names of all we want to pray for soon. We are also keeping Learning Tree in our prayers. This ministry of the church has 2, 3, and 4-year-old children learning skills for school and learning more about Jesus. Their first day of class will be September 9.

We need substitutes for the nursery. If you are willing to fill-in and help with the nursery let the church office know. In addition to Sunday morning we also need help with childcare on meeting nights and game nights.

Thank you for all of your concerns regarding **the parsonage.** I appreciate your prayers. At the moment I am staying in an RV at Buffalo RV Park. (Thanks to Steve and Linda Leverage for allowing the use of their RV.) This past week we got the results of the mold testing. The lab identified **two genera of mold present throughout the house, penicillium and aspergillus.** Because the parsonage was constructed in the 1960s, an asbestos test must be done as our next step. Once the asbestos test is done, a protocol for removing the mold can be written and we can move forward to the remediation of the mold. At the moment we are in a wait and see mode, but we are moving along as quickly as we can.

This Wednesday Terry and Lisa Langford are beginning the **Bible study of Treasures of a Transformed Life.** I want to thank everyone who signed up and I encourage you all attend this study.

With all of the things our church is doing, I want to remind us all that our purpose is to fulfill our mission: **At First United Methodist Church of Breckenridge we seek to make disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world by welcoming, sharing, and caring for each other and the community.** May we all seek through prayer and listening to God discernment for how God is leading you and me to respond to the fulfilling of the great commission included in our mission statement.
