**FROM THE PASTOR**

**JUNE, 2019**

Greetings in the name of Jesus Christ!

I am excited about the church and all the ways we are seeking to fulfill our purpose of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world by **welcoming, sharing and caring** for each other and the community. This month we seek to strengthen our relationships with one other with the Wings **annual salad luncheon on June 10<sup>th</sup>**, the **adult family game night on June 15<sup>th</sup>**, and the **covered dish lunch following worship and the debut of our newly formed praise band on June 30<sup>th</sup>**. I encourage you to invite someone to join you at each of these activities. Each of these events are great ways to introduce people to the church community and to Christ.

We also continue with our **ministry of compassion and mercy**. We have **Café Love** each Tuesday and the **mobile food pantry** each third Tuesday. This translates into 40 to 50 meals a week being served and about 180 people receiving food from the food pantry. Also, our church would be the **primary shelter** in Stephens County if a disaster such as a flood were to occur. I appreciate the many ways that our church gives back to the community, and I appreciate each one of you as you express your love for God through your service and faithfulness.

In June we also begin making our final preparations for **Vacation Bible School July 14<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup>**. We have lots of fun things in the works. So, mark your calendars. Our church will also organize and prepare the meals for **Feed My Lambs**. This is a ministry of preparing sack lunches for children in the down time when the school is not in session and is unable to prepare food for the children in need.

This coming week from **June 9<sup>th</sup> through June 12<sup>th</sup>** will be the meeting of the **Central Texas Conference's Annual Conference**. Historically this was the time that churches found out who was appointed to serve as their pastor for the next year. Now the mystery no longer exists; we now know well ahead of annual conference. **I will be reappointed as the pastor of First UMC Breckenridge and St. Paul UMC for this coming year**. Denise and I are looking forward in sharing this journey with you as we continue to look forward to what God has in store for us and the community.

This year at annual conference we will be **electing delegates to the General and Jurisdictional conferences**. The General Conference of 2020 is **the legislative body** of the United Methodist Church. They speak for the denomination and their decisions are reflected in the Book of Discipline. The Jurisdictional Conference has the primary function of **electing bishops**. Our bishop, Mike Lowry, will retire at the end of July in 2020. Do keep these processes in your prayers as our denomination continues to face some challenging issues related to ordination that were reflected in the called session of General Conference in 2019. I believe **God will continue to use the United Methodist Church to make disciples of Jesus Christ** as we all grow closer to God and see God working and living in all parts of our lives and world.
