**JUNE, 2020**

We as the church continue to move forward each day. There is a lot happening around us with the actions and reactions surrounding the death of George Floyd; the slow and cautious opening of the economy along with the impact of the COVID-19 on education and businesses around the world. We know things will be different but we are also assured that God will lead and guide us forward in new and impactful ways to gracefully share love and hope in peoples' lives so that others will welcome, embrace and share that love through their lives of faith. Rev. David Ferguson and his wife Susan are looking forward to serving in Breckenridge. My prayer is for the ministry of First UMC and St. Paul UMC to make a significant impact in this community and throughout the world. As I go on voluntary leave and move to Mississippi, I look forward to hearing how God is working through you and the ways that God is making a difference in the community of Breckenridge.

What's happening in June:

Worship for the month of June will continue to be one worship service in the CLC so that we can have social distancing. Everyone that attends will be required to sanitize their hands and put on a mask before entering the CLC. We will continue to not have congregational singing and no public restrooms. The service will be similar to the format we have been following to limit exposure in order to be as safe as possible. We will continue the Facebook livestream during this time. Persons are urged to use their best judgment about attending the live worship.

June 14 will be my last Sunday at First UMC Breckenridge and St. Paul UMC. Monday the 15<sup>th</sup> the movers will be at the parsonage to load the truck. The time between June 15 and 30 will be vacation time for me and I will begin my voluntary leave July 1.

At this time the Trustees are working on getting the parsonage free of the disturbed asbestos. Our District Superintendent, Dr. Lisa Neslony, has agreed to pay for the test to verify that the parsonage is safe and free of asbestos. This test will be on June 10. I will be making arrangements with the Trustees to get access to the parsonage so that Denise and I can pack our possessions that remain in the house.

Elaine has told Tim Byerly and me that she will be retiring from the position of Financial Secretary. At this time, we are looking for and talking with applicants.
